Discussion Questions

1. Throughout *Wonder*, Auggie describes that people immediately look away when they see his face for the first time. Have you ever been in a situation where you have responded like this to seeing someone different? Having read *Wonder*, how do you feel about it now?
2. Do adults and children treat Auggie differently in the book?
3. Who are Auggie's friends? What are they like?
4. Why did the author include so many different points of view? Did you find it helpful to see Auggie through other people's eyes?
5. Even though Auggie's story can be sad, the book is full of humor. Were there any parts that made you laugh?
6. Why do you think humor is important to this story?
7. What is a precept? (You can look it up!) What was your favorite precept from the book? What would your own precept be?
8. How does Auggie change over the course of this book? Why? Do other characters change?

9. How do you imagine Auggie in 5 years? What do you think his life will be like when he's an adult?

10. Would you recommend this book? If so, who would recommend it to and why?
